Sbarro Institute Post-Doc Named Woods Hole Fellow

February 28, 2007 (PHILADELPHIA, PA) – Laszlo Otvos, Jr., MD, research professor and director of drug development for the Sbarro Institute for Cancer Research and Molecular Medicine, has published one of the “Most Cited Articles: 2006” according to ACS Publications.

“Relaxin-3: Improved Synthesis Strategy and Demonstration of Its High-Affinity Interaction with the Relaxin Receptor LGR7 Both In Vitro and In Vivo,” originally appeared in the journal *Biochemistry*.

The recognition is based on citation data obtained from Thomson ISI and awarded for articles that cover “research of immediate interest.

In 2001, a paper published by Otvos in the same journal was cited as a “Hot Paper.” The designation recognizes papers that may signal important new trends in research and serve as leading indicators of new scientific advances.
