


- Click the ground to walk to that spot.

- For more control, click the **View** button at the bottom of the screen.




- To zoom in, hold the **Alt** key, then click and drag your mouse.


How to: Change your profile < >

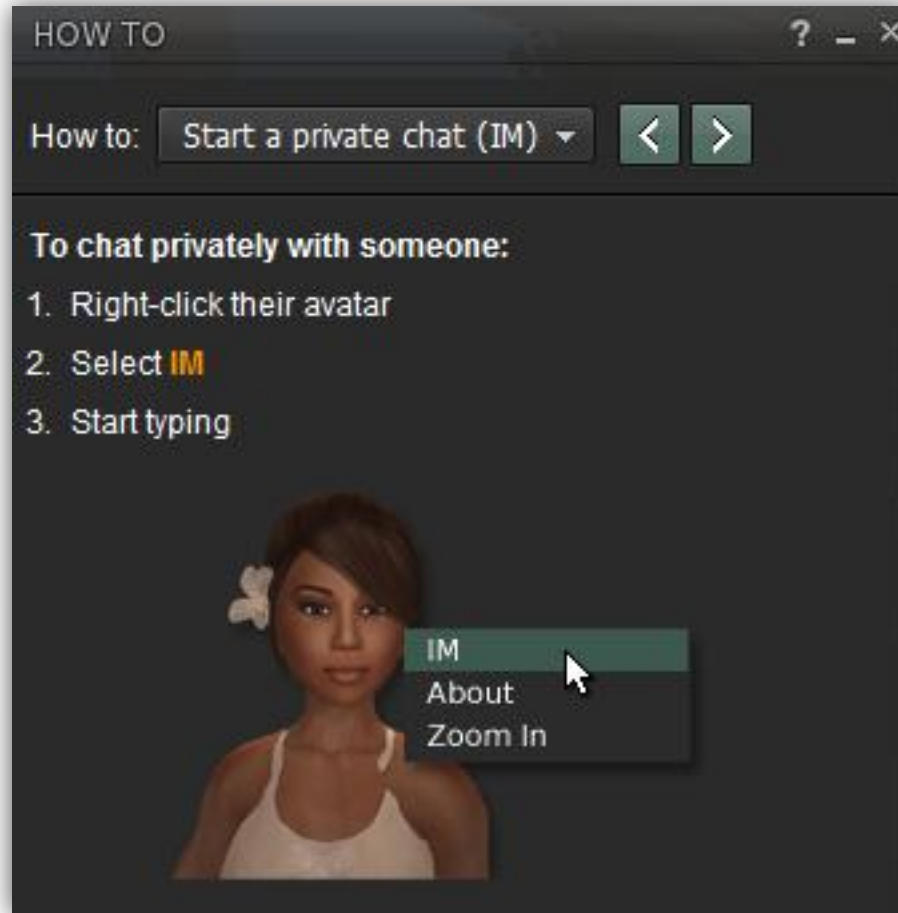
